Ain't Nothing Like the Real Thing

(9:1-5)

- The "first" covenant was not the ultimate covenant
- The tabernacle itself reveals its temporary nature
 - An earthly place of holiness
 - It was a tent
 - The earthly tent was filled with specific earthly, physical furniture and utensils
- "we cannot now speak in detail" (ESV)
 - "he has neither the time nor inclination" King
- Sufficient reminder of the physical, temporal nature of the instruments of the "first" covenant

Way Into the Holy Place Was Not Open

(9:6-10)

- The Most Holy Place was not accessible to all
 - Only to the High Priest
 - Only one day per year
 - Only after He sacrificed for his own sins
 - Only one right with God could intercede for others
- The Spirit intended all this to show the Law's limits
 - A "parable" for the "now" (9) "Intended to point beyond itself and provide a conceptual explanation for something else." – McClister
 - These sacrifices that cannot clear the conscience are...
- "until" the time of "revision or "correction" (10)

Christ, High Priest of a Better Tabernacle

(9:11-14)

- Christ, the <u>ultimate</u> High Priest....
 - ... entered the <u>ultimate</u> Most Holy Place
 - Not the temporary, earthly copy
- He entered "once for all"
 - Not to be regularly repeated like OT sacrifices
- He entered by the means of "His own blood"
 - Not the blood of bulls and goats
- The blood of bulls and goats served to purify the flesh
- The blood of Christ serves to clear the conscience of the worshipper from sin

Christ, Mediator of a New Covenant

(9:15-22)

- He is the mediator of a new covenant
 - Or "testament" as in "last will and testament"
 - So that, saints may receive an eternal inheritance
- His death took care of all sin for all time
- His death put the <u>ultimate</u> covenant into effect
- The first covenant was ratified with death
 - In fact, almost everything that was purified under the first covenant was purified with blood
 - (another "parable" to teach us that...)
- Without shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sin

Copies Have Given Way to The Heavenly

(9:23-28)

- The better things required a better sacrifice
 - The earthly was the copy
 - The heavenly is the reality
 - No more will an earthly priest enter an earthly sanctuary and use earthly utensils to repeatedly offer imperfect sacrifices
- Christ offered Himself one time for all time
- His redemptive work is sure & final (death & judgment)
 - He appeared once as the <u>ultimate</u> sacrifice for sin
 - He will return as the judge
 - "to save those who are eagerly waiting for Him"
