The Me Man and and Lazarus?

Have I received good things in this life?

- God is the source (James 1:16-17)
- Work to have to share
 - "Let the thief no longer steal, but rather let him labor, doing honest work with his own hands, so that he may have something to share with anyone in need." (Eph. 4:28)
- Be thankful and generous
 - "You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God." (2 Cor. 9:11)
 - Both are contagious

Am I indifferent to the suffering of others?

- Am I self-centered or self-absorbed?
 - "people who are self-centered aren't able to please God"

 (Rom. 8:8. CFB)
- Am I pre-occupied?
 - "the cares of the world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and it proves unfruitful." (Mt. 13:22)
- Do I love my neighbor?
 - Do I "go and do likewise" (Luke 10:37)
- Does God's love abide in me?
 - Do I back my words with action? (1 John 3:16-18)

- Am I waiting until it's too late to seek mercy?
- Do I despise God's kindness and patience? (Rom. 2:1-5)
- Am I still waiting...
 - to obey gospel?
 - to get serious about discipleship?
- I would, but...
 - "For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night."

(1 Thess. 5:2; see 2 Peter 3:10; Mt. 24:43)

"Now is the day of salvation" (2 Cor. 6:2)

Do I have loved ones I wish I could warn?

- Why don't we?
 - Fear of what we'll lose?
 - What about what they stand to lose?
- Why won't we?
- They ultimately will give an account (Heb. 9:27)
 - They "have Moses and the prophets" (Luke 16:29)
