



The Poor in Spirit (3)

- [those devoid of spiritual arrogance, those who regard themselves as insignificant] (AMP)
- "those who... comprehend their nothingness before God" McGarvey
- "those who recognize they are spiritually helpless" (GNT)
- "God blesses those who are poor and realize their need for him" (NLT)

The opposite of the Pharisees... and Laodiceans (Rev. 3:17)

Those who know the are spiritually bankrupt (Luke 18:13)

• "The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise." (Ps. 51:17)

Those Who Mourn (4)

- Not worldly grief that produces death (2 Cor. 7:10)
- Mourning over sin that separates from God
- Grieving for the loss of fellowship with God

Those who feel the weight of their spiritual poverty (Rom. 7)

Those who mourn are striving!

Those who don't mourn don't really repent!

Those who mourn their sin know the comfort of forgiveness

"For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret" (2 Cor. 7:10)

The Meek (5)

- The "gentle" gentleness is the manner of the meek
- The "humble" emphasizes the dependency of the meek
- "Meekness is rather the attitude of the soul towards another when that other is in a state of activity towards it." - Pulpit Commentary

The meek have the proper response to the Creator

- The meek are "ready to receive whatever teaching or chastisement might be given them" – Pulpit Commentary
- Meekness toward others hinges upon meekness toward God
 - "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself." (Mt. 22:37-39)

Those Who Hunger And Thirst For Righteousness (6)

- to crave ardently, to seek with eager desire; famishing
- "those who actively seek right standing with God" (AMP)

Those who pursue rightness with God and godly character

Kingdom people are committed to both doing and becoming

Only those who crave and seek God will ever be satisfied

 "O God, You are my God, earnestly I seek You; my soul thirsts for You; my body yearns for You in a dry and weary land without water."

(Ps. 63:1)

"For He satisfies the thirsty and fills the hungry with good things."

Ps. 107:9

Recognize they are spiritually helpless

So, they will seek and find the kingdom of God

Feel the weight of their spiritual poverty

And they know the comfort of forgiveness

Ready to receive whatever instruction is given them

 "are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells." (2 Pet. 3:13)

Pursue rightness with God and godly character

Kingdom people will be satisfied
