 - Rom. 1:21-28
- God waits for us, hopes for us, and desires us...
 - ... but He will not force us

Blesses generously (17)

- Even his hired hands
- How much more! (Lk. 7:11)
 - "I have been young, and now am old, yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken or his children begging for bread."
 - Ps. 37:25
- "the least in the kingdom is greater than he..." (Lk. 7:28)



462 God Will Take Care of You

Feels compassion (18-20)

- We know He's waiting
- He wants us to come home
- · He has pity for us
 - "Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost."
 - Luke 15:6
 - "I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents."
 - Luke 15:10



288 Lord I'm Coming Home

Forgives readily (21-24)

- Repentance & restoration
- Reconciliation <u>not</u> probation
- "My son was dead..."
 - His father knew the he had been separated from God
 - Rom. 6:23; Eph. 2:1
- "... and is alive again"
 - The Father will save through His amazing grace
 - Eph. 2:4-7



341 The Way of the Cross Leads Home

Endures patiently (25-32)

- The older son has been loyal to his father
 - But he is not like his father
 - We don't have to go to a far country to be lost...
- Still the father entreats
 - "Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours."
- He is our merciful Father
 - "It was <u>fitting</u> to celebrate and be glad..."
