

Faith endures trials

- helps us recognize the value of trials (1:2-4)
- keeps us focused on the reward (1:12; 5:7-8)

Faith prays to God

confidently and fervently (1:5-6; 5:13-18)

Faith overcomes temptations

- acknowledges the real source of temptations (1:13-16)
- produces doers of the word and not just hearers (1:22-25)

Faith works by love

- expresses itself in works like "visiting the orphans and widows in their distress" (1:27)
- restoring erring brethren (5:19-20)

Faith working by love will **NOT** be guilty of:

- partiality (2:1-9)
- speaking evil of one another (4:11-12)
- hoarding riches while ignoring the needs of others (5:1-6)

Faith controls the tongue

- prevents careless, undisciplined teaching (3:1-6)
- prohibits blessing and cursing from the same mouth (3:7-12)

Faith follows God's wisdom

discerns the fruit that wisdom produces (3:13-18)

Faith resists the allure of worldly pleasures

humbly draws near to God (4:1-10)

Faith does not arrogantly count on tomorrow

faith says, "if the Lord wills" (4:13-17)

"What use is it, my brethren, if someone says he has faith but he has no works?"
