WHAT HAS EVER DONE FOR US?

Colossians 1:12-14

"the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light" (12)

- Qualified to make sufficient, render fit
- God did something for us we could not do on our own
- He made us suitable to be partakers in light (14)
 - God is Light 1 John 1:5-7
 - Christ is the Light of the World John 8:12
 - Saints are to shine as lights Mt. 5:14-16
 - "you are light in the Lord, walk as children of light" Eph. 5:8

"the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light" (12)

- We are presently qualified and sharing
 - "For God... has shone in our hearts to give the Light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ." 2 Cor.4:6
 - "... for you are all sons of light and sons of day" 1 Thess. 5:5
 - 1 Pet. 2:9
- We will share in a greater future inheritance
 - 1 Pet. 1:3-5

"the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in light" (12)

- How did our Father qualify us?
- Through His beloved Son (14) "in whom we have **redemption**, the **forgiveness of sins**"

We should be "joyously giving thanks to the father"

- "delivered us from the domain of darkness" (13)
 - **Deliver** to rescue, deliver (from danger or destruction)
- We were captive to sin and death Rom. 6:16
 - "Do you not know that when you present yourselves to someone as slaves for obedience, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin resulting in death, or of obedience resulting in righteousness?"
- He rescued us from death Eph. 2:1-6; 5:8
- We will be delivered **eternally** Rom. 5:8-10

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him. For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled we shall be saved by His life."

- Rom. 5:8-10

"delivered us from the domain of darkness" (13)

- How did our Father deliver us?
- Through His beloved Son (14)
 "in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins"

We should be "joyously giving thanks to the father"

"transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son" (13)

- Transfer change of situation or place, to re-settle
- They... from Jewish Law or pagan idolatry Eph. 2:19-22
- We... from the domain, rule, sphere of darkness
- We are in the kingdom of "the Son of His love"
 - Like the Colossians... in His church
 - His eternal kingdom that came with power Mark 9:1
- His **church** will be handed over in the end 1 Cor. 15:24

"... then comes the end, when He hands over the kingdom to the God and Father, when He has abolished all rule and all authority and power."

- 1 Cor. 15:24

"transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son" (13)

- How did our Father transfer us?
- Through His beloved Son (14)
 "in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins"

We should be "joyously giving thanks to the father"
