### Genesis 35:1-3

### Put Away Foreign Gods

- Remove everything that would compete with God for our affection and devotion
  - "Little children, guard yourselves from idols." 1 John 5:21
  - Idols any object that competes with God for our devotion
  - Our idols? things, stuff, others and self.
- Foretaste of the 10 commandments
  - "You shall have no other gods before me" Ex. 20:3
- God demands our full allegiance (Matt. 6:24)
  - You cannot serve God and

## Purify Your Heart

- Language used later to describe the purifications of the law
  - Num. 19:11-13; Lev. 14:4; 15:13
- Object of purification is the heart
  - "For out of the heart come evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, slanders. These are the things which defile the man; but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile the man." – Matt. 15:19-20
- What are we filling our hearts with? (Phil. 4:8)
- Drawing near to God begins in the heart (Heb. 10:22)

## Change Your Garments

- "... representative of moral and spiritual purification of the mind and heart..." – Pulpit Commentary
  - Subsequently at Sinai (Ex. 19:10-11)
- We must be clothed in Christ (Gal. 3:27)
- He must become our "walking around clothes" (Rom. 13:12-14)
  - "Put on the armor of light" (cf. Eph. 6:11)
  - What we "put on" everyday
  - What we wear in every situation and setting
  - "put on the Lord Jesus Christ..."

### Set to Sacrifice

- God wants us to offer acceptable sacrifices to Him
  - "Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship." (Rom. 12:1)
- Following Jacob's guidance will get us Set to Sacrifice
  - Put Away Foreign Gods
  - Purify Your Heart
  - Change Your Garments
