Such is the kingdom of God Childlike

- 1 Cor. 14:20 "Brethren, do not be children in your thinking; yet in evil be infants, but in your thinking be mature."
- Childish: immature, wanting what we like rather than what we need
- Childlike: innocence
- 1 Pet. 2:2 "like newborn babies" long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation"
 - "long for" crave! must grow (2 Pet. 3:18)
- "pure" free of guile / no bias or slant

Such is the kingdom of God Simple

Simple – Naïve; willing to actually accept and believe <u>God!</u>

Ps. 119:130 "The unfolding of Your words gives light; It gives understanding to the simple."

"needing" [Brown-Driver-Briggs] / "inexperienced" (CSB)

Ps. 116:6 "The LORD preserves the simple..."

Not a lack of intelligence, a lack of understanding (Eph. 4:17-19)

"... I was brought low, and He saved me."

But they "learned" Christ (Eph. 4:20-21)

Such is the kingdom of God Simple

The Kingdom of God is for the simple

- "At that time Jesus said, "I praise You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and intelligent and have revealed them to infants." (Matt. 11:25)
- Kingdom life will not appeal to worldly "intellectuals" (1 Cor. 1:26-27)

The simple are satisfied with simplicity

 "But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ." (2 Cor. 11:3)

Such is the kingdom of God Receptive

Receptive – malleable; not hardened; willing to listen and change

Job 22:22 "Please receive instruction from His mouth and establish His words in your heart."

Bereans (Acts 17:11) "more noble-minded"/"more receptive" (ISV)

We must accept the word for what it really is (1 Thess. 2:13)

Prov. 15:32 "He who neglects discipline despises himself, but he who listens to reproof acquires understanding."

self-loathing / guilt – those who ignore God's will
