# Honor everyone.

- Respect and value all people
  - Hold no one in contempt or think of them as beneath us
- God made us all (Acts 17:26)
- Jesus died for us all (John 3:16)
- All means all
  - Jew or Gentile... it makes no difference
  - Nationality, race, color... it makes no difference
  - Rich, poor, conservative, liberal... it makes no difference
- The first step in elevating others is humbling self

### Love the brotherhood.

- Above our esteem for all, show affection for our brethren
  - "as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith." (Gal. 6:10)
- agapé active goodwill for that person's benefit or welfare
- Brotherly love "does not insist on its own way" (1 Cor. 13:5)
  - "Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor." (Rom. 12:10)
  - "It is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that causes your brother to stumble." (Rom. 14:21)
- True love is "sincere", "earnest" and "pure" (1 Pet. 1:22)

#### Love the brotherhood.

- Reflects directly on our relationship with God
  - "By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:35)
- What does our love for our brethren show?
  - The time we spend with them?
  - What we do for them?
  - What we say about them?
- "If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen." (1 John 4:20)

### Fear God.

#### Jesus said:

- "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength."
   (Mark 12:30)
- "And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul."
  Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell."
  (Matt. 10:28)
- Love & fear are not opposites and not mutually exclusive
- Love & fear blend in true "reverence" and "deference"
- Peter said, "fear God"

# Honor the emperor.

- Be subject to civil authorities for the Lord's sake (2:13-15)
  - Usual caveats apply (Acts 4:19; 5:29)
- Respect and value the king and his agents
  - He is due "honor" but not adoration or worship
  - "They were to submit and to honor, but not to fear, the reigning ruler. Christians do not fear rulers in the same way they fear God."
