



- A Movement: Distinct and Separate
- Distinct "Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God" 1 Cor. 10:32
  - The church is as distinguishable and different as Jews were from Gentiles
  - Jews knew it. Gentiles knew it. Christians knew it.
  - Jews and Gentiles persecuted. The church persevered.
- Separate "Go out from their midst, and be separate from them, says the Lord..." 2 Cor. 6:17
- There is <u>one body</u>, one Spirit, one hope, one Lord, one faith, one baptism, just as certainly as there is one God Eph. 4:4-6

- Conflict with religious establishment
  - Acts 9:2 "and asked him for letters to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any belonging to the Way, men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem"
  - Acts 22: 4 "I persecuted this Way to the death, binding and delivering to prison both men and women"
    - Don't be surprised when other religious people persecute us
  - Acts 19:9 "But when some became stubborn and continued in unbelief, speaking evil of the Way before the congregation, he withdrew from them and took the disciples with him, reasoning daily in the hall of Tyrannus"
    - · We should expect other religious people to oppose us and even speak evil of us

Conflict with religious establishment

"They will put you out of the synagogues. Indeed, the hour is coming when whoever kills you will think he is offering service to God"

- John 16:2

#### Conflict with the world

- Acts 19:23 "About that time there arose no little disturbance concerning the Way"
  - The truth of God is a threat to the gods which men have made Acts 19:26

#### The changes in your life illuminate their need to change

- 1 Pet. 3:16 "keeping a clear conscience, so that those who slander you may be put to shame by your good behavior in Christ"
- 1 Pet. 4:4 "they are surprised when you do not join them in the same flood of debauchery, and they malign you"

#### This realization is part of counting the cost

• 2 Tim. 3:12 – "all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted"

Conflict with the world

""If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you"

- John 15:18

#### Conflict with the government

- Acts 24:22 "But Felix, having a rather accurate knowledge of the Way, put them off, saying, "When Lysias the tribune comes down, I will decide your case"
- Paul's prosecution begins the legal separation of the Way from Judaism
  - Shatters the view that the church was just another sect of Jews
  - Sets up Roman persecution
- Growing Roman persecution provides the backdrop for the Revelation
  - Rev. 13:11-12 "Then I saw another beast rising out of the earth. It had two horns like a lamb and it spoke like a dragon. It exercises all the authority of the first beast in its presence, and makes the earth and its inhabitants worship the first beast..."

Conflict with the government

"Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God,
for his judgments are true and just;
for he has judged the great prostitute
who corrupted the earth with her immorality,
and has avenged on her the blood of his servants"

- Revelation 19:1-2

#### Having a hope in God

- Acts 24:14 "But this I confess to you, that according to the Way, which they call a sect,
  I worship the God of our fathers, believing everything laid down by the Law and written in
  the Prophets"
- Acts 24:15 "having a hope in God, which these men themselves accept, that there will be a resurrection of both the just and the unjust"

### All spiritual blessings are in Christ Jesus – Eph. 1:3ff

- Eph. 1:4 God chose those "in Christ" to be "holy and blameless before Him"
- Eph. 5:27 "so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish"

Having a hope in God

"I am **the way**, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me"
