



## "Wherever You Go" Sacrifice (57-58)

- Easy to say, harder to do
- No promise of making this life better
  - Guard against expectations, disappointment and disillusionment
- Self-sacrifice is only reasonable
  - "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship." (Rom 12:1-2)

## "Lord, Let Me First..." Priority (59-60)

- When we hear His call, and eventually... someday...
  - There are questions about the request
    - "Second burial" tradition?
  - There are questions about Jesus' response
    - Let the "spiritually dead" bury the "physically dead"?
    - OT High Priest forbidden to "go in to dead bodies..." (Lev 21:11)
- There is no question, it is a matter of priorities (Matt 6:33)
  - "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me."

    (Matt 10:37)

## "I Will Follow You, Lord, but..."

Commitment (61-62)

- Mostly committed... is not committed at all
  - "Remember Lot's wife." (Luke 17:32)
  - "Whoever seeks to preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life will keep it." (Luke 17:33)
  - Catch ourselves when we long for "Egypt" (Num 11:4-6)
- The danger of following at a distance (Matt 26:58, 69-75)
  - Let's learn what Peter learned (2 Pet 2:20-22)
- A good soldier is unentangled (2 Tim 2:4) and focused...
  - "But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead..." (Phil 3:13)
