

## The Reports About Jesus

Mark 5:27

#### Capernaum - "His own city" (Mt. 9:1)

- He astonished with His teaching in the synagogue - Mk. 1:21-22
- He cast out an unclean spirit Mk. 1:23-28

#### Other miracles at Capernaum:

- Healed Peter's mother-in-law Mk. 1:29-31
- Healed and cast out demons Mk. 1:32-34
- Healed the paralytic Mk. 2:1-12 (10-12)
- Healed the centurion's servant without even seeing him - Mt. 8:5-13

Mark 5:27

"And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You will be brought down to Hades. For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. But I tell you that it will be more tolerable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom than for you."

Mark 5:24-34

27 She had heard the reports about Jesus and came up behind him in the crowd and touched his garment.

28 For she said, "If I touch even his garments, I will be made well."

29 And immediately the flow of blood dried up, and she felt in her body that she was healed of her disease.

30 And Jesus, perceiving in himself that power had gone out from him, immediately turned about in the crowd and said, "Who touched my garments?" 31 And his disciples said to him, "You see the crowd pressing around you, and yet you say, 'Who touched me?'" 32 And he looked around to see who had done it.

33 But the woman, knowing what had happened to her, came in fear and trembling and fell down before him and told him the whole truth.

34 And he said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace, and be healed of your disease."
